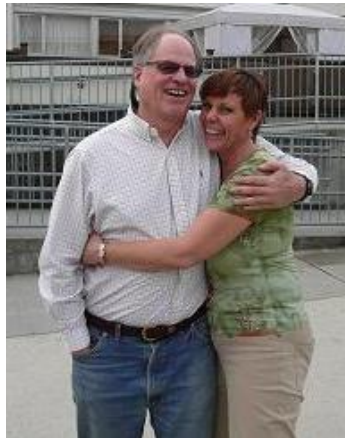
***Pre-requisite: Peacemaking Circle Training***
